“What shall I render to the Lord for all his bounty to me?” Psalms 116:
How often do you say, “Give me this,” or “Give me that?” How many times a day do you ask for things? Someone has said that this is the age of “Gimmee” People are always asking for something. They want something for nothing. They want large prizes. They want high wages and short hours. They want long vacations and good times. They want the Government to take care of them. They think that God should give them everything they ask for. They think that all there is to prayer is to ask God for things. They say “Gimmiee” to God. It never enters their minds that they owe God something. Instead of asking “What can I give to God?”

The prodigal son was selfish. He wanted his own way. He wanted a good time. He wanted to leave home. He thought his life was dull. He thought only of himself. He never asked what he could do for his father, or what he could give him. He said, “Father give me the share of property that falls to me. “His father did so, and the boy left for the city.
